A. The Treaty System and its contradictions.

What did the peace Treaty system consist in? *Old and New method.*  
Not a system, but ~~two~~ mutually contradictory systems.  
Unless general disarmament came, the so-called system would suddenly vanish *The Kings new clothes.*

B. The alignment of powers.

*Not "Revision" but military disarmament of the world.*  
*Lack of equality of states.*  
Revisionist and anti revisionist.  
Germany Austria Hungary Bulgaria Turkey  
diplomatically supported by Russia and Italy  
France, Poland the Little Entente. plus Great Britain.

C. Possible solutions (apart from universal disarmament) :

- a revision *art 16* Interdependence of the two.
- b collective security. *art 19*

The failure of France and England to act simultaneously.
