"Social Action and Technological Change"

PROPOSAL FOR ANNUAL CONFERENCE, MAY, 1965

adopted by National Executive

You are invited to submit the outline of a paper to be presented at the 1965 Exchange Conference, which will be concerned with the action that society will have to take as a result of rapid technological change.

The Conference is planned as a report on a year's work, by branches or by individual members. One or more outlines, each of about 200 words, should be sent to the Conference Chairman by October 1st. The form of the Conference will be decided at that time, and all participants will be kept informed of each others approaches. Not all the suggested papers will be accepted, because some may overlap the area covered elsewhere, or because a dominant theme of interest may become apparent and certain submissions would then appear inconsistent. The outline, therefore, should describe the work that you or your branch would be interested in doing and you will be informed as soon as possible how this would fit in with work underway elsewhere.

By this means, and by requesting papers on topics which would otherwise not be covered, it is hoped to arrange a coherent meeting. With adequate cross reference, and by circulating all papers before the conference, we should be able to avoid much of the semantic and other confusion which always occurs when discussants meet for the first time at the conference itself. It might be thought advisable not to read complete papers at all, but to expect all participants to have done their homework; a synopsis could be given, leaving most of the time for discussion.

It should be noted that we do not want vague statements that things are changing, or exhortations that somebody ought to be doing something. There has been a great deal of that already. If funds permit, copies of background papers will be sent to members, if not, references will be given in the hope that you will obtain your own.

What we do want is a sober assessment presented as concretely as possible, of the public action that has to be taken to meet the challenge.

This approach to a Conference demands a great deal more work from participants but it is altogether more satisfying. It should also help to establish Exchange as an organisation devoted to work and thought, rather than polemic.

It is widely suggested that technological change, especially in automation, is changing the world as fundamentally as did the Industrial Revolution. There is less agreement on the speed with which this is taking place, but little doubt that it will be compressed into a far shorter period than the onset of the industrial age. In any case, this is not a problem for the future alone. A great deal of uncertainty—let alone unemployment—is occuring among young people already. Are we to be overwhelmed by the tide of events? Is it necessary that we take far more active measures to meet thenew situation? And if so what measures?

Political parties must inevitably prepare platforms which could be implemented within the lifetime of a single parliament, and this preoccupation with immediate and pressing problems — with tactics — prevents them from paying enough attention to longer-term issues — to strategy. These very tactical problems often arise because strategy has been neglected.

In the view of many experts our society will become almost unrecognisable within the lifetime of today's youth; we have a responsibility to prevent chaos. This is not too strong a term. President Kennedy, the U.S. Secretary of Labour, and the President of U.S. Industries have variously estimated that between one and two million jobs will shortly be disappearing each year in the U.S. If overwhelming unemployment is to be avoided there must be fundamental economic reorganisation and major changes in our educational system. How should our traditional political principles be applied to these new problems?

There is no doubt that for the great majority the decision to delete "left-wing" from the draft was an act without ideological significance. A small group supported the deletion in order to facilitate the participation of publicly-employed persons in the organization. A few more (there was only one spokesman in debate) was of an avowedly apolitical temperament and wanted Exchange to be a civic rather than a politically-oriented body. The majority of those who voted for deletion did so either because they thought it would be better public relations or because of a distaste for emotional political terminology which defies classification in terms of ideology (many academics dislike the term for this reason). The mover of the amendment, who is a militant New Democratic Party intellectual was solely motivated by consideration of public relations. He, and a great number of those who supported his amendment would be utterly mortified if they were themselves to be described as anything but "Leftwingers".

Far more political significance attached to an amendment proposed by James Doull. He sought to replace the various political descriptions with the one term "social democratic". In doing so, Professor Doull made it clear that there is profound difference between liberals and socialists as he understands the terms both in relation to their domestic political philosophy and in respect of their view of the ultimate destiny of Canada in its relations with the United States. Unless Exchange showed its awareness of this difference, which Prof. Doull saw as being symbolised in his amendment, then Exchange could only become yet another of the forces leading Canada inexorably toward "The American Way of Life".

It is extremely regrettable that Professor Doull's ideas should have been discussed in connection with an amendment to the constitutional statement of aims and purposes. Many of the questions he raised, the considerations he posed, belong to the area that Exchange must study. The Conference's attitude was not necessarily one of opposi-

tion to Prof. Doull's point of view. It was rather one of unwillingness to take it as a fixed position which would be advanced as the only motivating principle of Exchange.

Prof. Doull's paper will be published, together with all other papers delivered at the Conference, in the form of an Exchange paperback book. No attempt is made in this Newsletter therefore to summarise the addresses and discussion upon Provincial and Federal Government and upon the Canadian Constitution.

Exchange FOR POLITICAL IDEAS JIN CANADA No. 6

THE FOUNDING CONFERENCE

The notion dies hard that Exchange has been created for some purpose other than that it declares. The presence at the Exchange Founding Conference of active political party intellectuals, some holding elective office and some not, led to widespread newspaper speculation about "party mergers" and (most particularly!) about the demise of the "splinter parties" and the desirability of the "two-party system". Such editorialising was especially common (as in the Vancouver and Victoria press) where the New Democratic Party is strong and where newspaper orientation is most consciously to the political right. Exchange is founded on the premise that members of different political parties can talk co-operatively to each other without disloyalty to their party; that political intellectuals can continue to have intellectual integrity after election to office; that an interest in politi-cal policy and ideology is expressible through other vehicles than a political party; that party politicians are capable of objective thought in the public interest at least to the same degree as other men.

The 205 registrants at the Founding Conference included both militant political party members—strong proponents of ideological positions and educationists and researchers without political party affiliation. With very few exceptions they found each other interesting, treated each other goodhumouredly, found something they agreed with in most speakers and something they

disagreed with. They clearly thought they had much to contribute to each other and with a few exceptions that Exchange had much potential significance for progressive political life in Canada.

Different interpretations have been given to the debate which took place upon the draft "Aims and Purposes" of Exchange. The symbolic term "left-wing" had been included in the draft as a general description of that area of our national political life to which Exchange saw itself as belonging. The draft further particularised the "leftwing" as those who saw themselves as liberals, or progressives, or radicals, or socialists, or independents who had affinity with these. An amendment for the deletion of the term "left-wing" was voted upon by 141 members, 71 for the amendment and 70 against. In some commentaries this vote has been taken as indicating that Exchange will have no particular political attitude and no special political sympathy for the left. It is quoted as further evidence that the New Democrats in particular are in Exchange only to prepare the way for a "Merger".

This false interpretation is harmful to Exchange in that it creates apprehension both in political party members who would like to belong to Exchange and whom Exchange needs but who are sensitive to charges – always quick to be made – of incipient disloyalty to the party. Political activity that a Party Establishment does not control it tends to distrust.
