These peltoviships were founded under the terms of a cift made by the Rt. Non. Tord Simon of "ythenshawe, of Tidsbury, in 191/ for the promotion of research and teaching in the Social Sciences, this term being construed in a wide sense. The Feltowships are intended to set free for research and writing men and women of mature years who are considered by the University to be capable of doine work likely to prove of practical importance. The Fellowships may be held wholly or bartly in Menchester or may be used for traveliting to any part of the world. The regulations were amended in 7053 to provide for the award of Simon Research Fellomships and Simon Senior Research Pellowshios.

7. The Tniversity will offer annually oneor more Simon Research Feltowships for advanced study or research in the Social Siences. The Fellowships wilt be onen to candidates of about ten years' standino from the date of their first depree. ?. The Fellowships will be tenable for one year, with a possible extension to two years, and, in very exceotional circumstances, to three. The Fel Tow will be recuired to devote his whole time to the maties of the Fellowship. 3. The $\mathrm{Fe}_{\mathrm{e}}$ lowshios shall normal ly be within the renge of $7700-7,100$ p.a. (Simon Pesearch Fellowships) or within the renge of $57750-7500$ per annum fimon Senior Research Fellowships). accordino to the experience and quelification of the person elected. The emoluments of the Tellowships shall be payable quarterly, subject to the receipt of satisfactory mogmensm reports of progress. L. Tellows who are already members of the Federated Superanmation System for Iniversities shall continue their membership, and in other cases a pellow who so desires may, with the consent of the University, be proposed for membership of the schene. In all cases the fill contributions shall be a charge on the emoluments of the Tellowship.
8. Fellows other than those who, at the time of election, are members of the staff of this inniversity, will normally be remired to be resødent in Manchester during their period of temure, but a fellow may be permitted to devote such periods as may be deemed desirable by the Simon Research Fund Committee to research elsewhere under conditions approved by the Committee.
9. Turing or immeriately after his temure of the Rellowship, the Fellow will be remired to give a lecture or Tectares in the University on the subject of his study or research. He wil7 also be reouired to deposit in the Tniversity Tibrary two copies of amy memoir or book embodyine the results of his study or mesearch.

## SIMON FELLOWGHIPS.

These Fellowships were founded under the terms of a gift made by the Rt. Hon, Lord Simon of Wythenshawe of Didsbury, in 1944, for the promotion of reseerch and teaching in the Social Sciences, this term being construed in a wide sense. The Followships are intended to set iree for research and writing men and women of mature yaars who are considered by the University to be cepable of dotng work likely to prove of practical importince. The Fellowships may be held wholly or pertiy in Manchester or may be used for travelilins to any part of the world. The regulations were amended in 1953 to provide for the eward of Simon Research Fellowships and Simon Senior Research Followships.

## REGULATIONS

1. The Jniversity will offor annually one or more Simon Fellowships for advanced study or research in the Sociel Sciences. Tho Followships will be opon to candicetes of about ten years' standing from the date of their first degree.
2. Tho Fllowships will bo tenable for one year with a possible extension to two years, and, in very exceptional circumstances, to three. The Follow will be recuired to devote his whole time to the duties of the Fellowship.
3. The Fellowships shall normally be within the range of $£ 700-£ 1100$ per annum (Simon Resoarch Fellowships) or within the range of fll50£1500 por annum (Simon Sonior Research Fellowships), according to the oxperience and quaifications of the persons elected. The emoluments of the Fellowships shall be payablo quarterly, subject to the recelpt of sotisfectory roports of progross.
4. Follows who are already membors of the Fedoratod Superannuation Systom for Universitios shall continue their momborship and in other cases a Fellow who so desircs may, with the consont of the Universjty, bo proposed for membership of tho scheme. In 211 cases tho full contribution shall be a charge on the emoluments of the Fellowship.
5. Follows, other than those who, the time of election, are members of the staff of this University will normelly bo required to be resident jn Manchoster during their period of tenure, but a Fellow mey be permittod to devoto such periods as may be deemod desirable by the Simon Research Fund Comittee to rcsearch elsewhere under conditions approved by the Committee.
6. During or immediately after tenuro of the Fellowship, the Fellow will bo roquired to give e. lecturo or lectures in the University on tho subject of his study or roscarch. He will also be required. to denosit in the University Librery two copies of any memoir or book ombodying the results of his study or research.

Applications must roech the Registrar of the University by lst March in the yoar of application.
